Though he makes reference to futuristic inventions designed to improve travel speed in the Introduction to The Twenty-One Balloons, his tale of the haphazard journey of Professor William Waterman Sherman is one of 19th-century adventure, not Nuclear Age rapidity. In a plot that could have been taken from Jules Verne, du Bois has his elderly hero sailing around the world from San Francisco in a balloon and landing on the now-extinct island of Krakatoa.
