Prerequisites Prior to completing this course, it is highly recommended that the student have: -Opened the Geospatial Information System Specialist (GISP) task book, or -Held the equivalent position in the NRCC/RRCC (when developed) Students must also have basic geospatial knowledge and skills, including: -Knowledge of how to make a map and other geospatial products -Knowledge of basic analytics -Knowledge of the basic fundamentals of cartography and geospatial terminology -The ability to use standard GIS software and equipment such as: -ESRI’s ArcGIS software, including Spatial Analyst -Adobe products -Google Earth -Large format printers -Microsoft Office suite -Handheld GPS devices -Modeling and decision support software such as HAZUS -Computers Note: Students may come to FEMA with prior geospatial training and knowledge, or it may be developed through on-the-job training or courses.
