This study aimed to evaluate the effects of a didactic plus hybrid simulation education intervention on medical-surgical nurses' knowledge and confidence levels when providing tracheostomy care. Current literature reports a general lack of confidence and knowledge of evidence-based tracheostomy care practices amongst healthcare providers. A pretest-posttest design was used to study the effects of a brief didactic session combined with hybrid simulation on medical-surgical nurses' knowledge and confidence test scores. Nineteen medical-surgical nurses, 14 intensive care nurses, and 3 respiratory therapists at a small, rural hospital in Southwest Virginia participated in the study. Mean scores of confidence and knowledge before and after the education intervention were analyzed using paired t-tests. There was a statistically significant difference in the pretest scores for knowledge and confidence compared to posttest scores for all nurses in the study. Years of experience and confidence pretest scores were found to be positively correlated to current knowledge and confidence scores, $r(34) = .30, p = .042$. No statistically significant correlations were found among the other variables. Limitations to this study included the small sample size and limitation to one hospital. Tracheostomy care is an important technical skill that must be performed safely and appropriately to prevent patient complications. The study results contribute to the development of best practices when teaching the important skill of tracheostomy care to increase healthcare providers' knowledge and confidence levels and improve patient outcomes.

In 2008, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) announced that payment would not be rendered for certain conditions determined to be hospital-acquired (Kuhn, 2008). One such condition, identified in the 2008 announcement, is pressure ulcers. Although several guidelines and quality improvement initiatives have been developed to guide and improve tracheostomy care, concerns continue to exist over the possible decannulation of the patient while performing such care (Fiona, 2010). Specifically, the increased occurrence of skin breakdown at the tracheostomy site over the last two years has caused hospital-wide concern. Limited and outdated research exists for prevention of skin breakdown at the tracheostomy site. Gauze dressing is the highly preferred intervention by the institution's nurses in the prevention of tracheostomy skin breakdown when compared to the use of a Duo Derm dressing on patients in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). The purpose of this paper is to compare two types of dressings that are being used in the prevention of tracheostomy skin breakdown, and identify an evidenced based protocol and make recommendations for further research to examine and test new products that claim to prevent skin breakdown. The study will conduct a case study analysis of patients using two different types of dressings with a subsequent comparison of the data. The data analyzed was secondhand data that was obtained within the scope of nursing practice of 45 patients who had the two products applied under their tracheostomies based on physician service. The data confirmed researchers' theories that the best dressing to be used in preventing skin breakdown will be the gauze dressing. The data results also show that nothing is 100% full proof and that further research must be conducted as new products enter the market. Identifying an evidenced base best practices protocol will allow for better care of patients in preventing skin breakdown at the tracheostomy site, and prevent significant losses in fees.
