Zion to Bryce Canyon – Take US-89 N and UT-12 E for just over 72 miles, or reverse the directions if heading the opposite direction. Drive time should be around 1 hour 20 minutes on a clear day. Las Vegas to Zion National Park – Take I-15 N to exit 16 and UT-9. Distance is 160 miles and drive time is just over 2 hours and 30 minutes

Arrive at Bryce Canyon National Park, and see the colorful Claron limestone rock formations, including slot canyons, windows, fins, and spires called hoodoos. Stop for a picnic lunch, which is provided. Continue to Zion National Park at the junction of the Colorado Plateau, Great Basin, and Mojave Desert provinces in southwestern Utah.

Taking this approach, you enter the park through the Zion-Mount Carmel Tunnel, emerging on the other end smack in the middle of a giant, awe-inspiring canyon, a playground for campers, sightseers, hikers and adventurers of every stripe and color. How to Road-Trip Through Arches, Bryce and Zion National ...

This is Part 1 of a two-part series, and this itinerary will cover the closest parks to Las Vegas for a one-week trip to Zion National Park, Bryce Canyon National Park, and some lesser-known but equally fabulous scenic areas of southwestern Utah. All three campgrounds and all the parks mentioned in this report are open year round.

A Perfect 7-Day Itinerary for Zion and Bryce Canyon ...

The driving distance from Bryce Canyon to Zion National Park is only about 80 miles(128km) and takes about 1:40 straight through. Driving from Zion to Bryce Canyon instead? Simply reverse these directions and take the Zion Mount Carmel highway east out of the park, then route 89 north until you get to route 12.

There are the towering walls of Zion Canyon and Kolob Canyon, the narrow canyons of the Subway, white sandstone mesas, and even some arches and bridges. The Grand Canyon's South Rim National Park is about 281 miles from Las Vegas—a drive of roughly 4-5 hours.
